



Police Closure Powers

The Licensing Act 2003 ('The Act') expands police application of court powers, to close all licensed premises and premises with a temporary event notice for up to 24 hours, where disorder is occurring or anticipated.

This includes pubs, nightclubs, restaurants and hotels, as well as one-off raves.

The Act also bans the sale of alcohol on any moving motor vehicle and brings river and coastal "booze cruises" into the licensing regime, extending the police closure powers to them.
