



Fire precautions: what happens next?

Will I need to improve fire precautions? Possibly. If your premises are already fully compliant with the old legislation then any changes should be straightforward.

There may be some additional work and costs required, however, where fire precautions have not previously been kept up to date.

Will my premises still be inspected by the Fire and Rescue Service?

Some premises, particularly higher risk premises, may well still be inspected by the Fire and Rescue Service to ensure that they meet the requirements set out in the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005.

However, it should be remembered that the Fire and Rescue Service cannot undertake your Fire Risk Assessment on your behalf and you should complete it prior to any visits by the Service.
