



What if I fail to produce my licence to the court?

What happens if I am convicted for a relevant offence, but I failed to produce my licence to the court (or notify them of its existence)?

This is also an offence. It also becomes your duty to notify the licensing authority that granted the licence of the conviction for the relevant offence, and any sentence imposed. This notice must be accompanied by the personal licence, or a statement explaining why it was not enclosed. Failure to do this, without reasonable excuse, is an offence.

The sentence on conviction of this offence is a fine of up to £500, and could result in the forfeiture or suspension of the licence.
